There has been lots of happiness, laughter, giggles and chuckles with my little (and not so little!) canine customers, who experience one-to-one attention in the Salon. It is always hard when any of us lose a pet and so there has been some sadness too when I learned that 2 of my delightful canine customers had passed away.

There have been requests from several people for an opportunity to work with Wagg-On which is a huge compliment! Working largely alone, I take my continued professional development very seriously and I have attended several

workshops on everything from canine behaviour to first aid, as well as grooming and styling, which continues to build on my City and Guilds qualification. Putting into practice what I have learned, positive reinforcement of desired canine behaviour is my approach.....and this involves high value treats such as chicken, bacon, liver – a hit with most of my pooches!

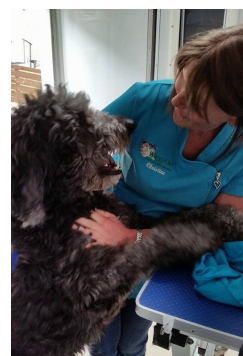
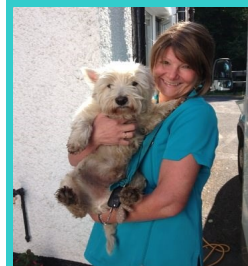
As for the future? Well, I have lots of plans for Wagg-On, so let's just say....watch this space!
